ore often than not residents do not attend our AGM and do not realise how important this meeting really is. One of the most compelling reasons to attend the AGM is to get better knowledge of the workings of the HOA as well as its financial status.

Important decisions are made at an AGM – especially related to the annual increase in the monthly levy. It provides owners with the opportunity to understand future plans and they have the chance to ask any questions they may have related to all aspects of the Estate. One simply cannot complain about the decisions made at an AGM if one is not prepared to participate in the process.

We must not forget that the HOA is a company in which every owner in the Estate has considerable investment. "This is, after all, a business, one in which millions of rands in asset value are managed and it must be treated with the same seriousness you would treat any business of that scale," says Michael Bauer of the property management company, IHFM.

Of course, not everyone will be able to attend the AGM for various reasons and that is where the importance of a Proxy comes in. Select the person to hold your proxy with care. By appointing a proxy, you are nominating that person to act on your behalf at the meeting, so make sure you are aligned in your thoughts about the decisions that are to be made. Proxies also form part of the attendance register and ensure that the meeting has a quorum and can therefore proceed as planned.

Last year, we were one person short of a quorum – to our relief, a latecomer saved the day. If we don't have a quorum, we have to close the meeting and reschedule for the following week. This is both a hinderance and a waste of money! So, if you are unable to make it on the 26th, please complete a proxy so that the meeting can go ahead.

One of the other important processes that takes place at the AGM is the election of Directors. These are individuals who have the same responsibilities and duties as overseeing any other business – managing the finances, ensuring there is good service delivery from suppliers, strategic planning, guiding the Estate Office etc. Participating on the Board can be very rewarding! It is an opportunity to serve the community by both protecting and enhancing the assets of the Estate. We encourage all residents to consider giving of their time to their community and join the Board.

Another important date in May is Mother's Day on Sunday the 13th. This is an opportunity to show appreciation for your mother and mother figures and thank them for their love, care and support. I would like to wish all the Mums in the Estate a very happy Mother's Day – may you be spoilt and treasured by your family.



THE BEST HERBS TO PLANT IN AUTUMN

THERE'S NOTHING BETTER THAN BEING ABLE TO PICK YOUR OWN HERBS FROM YOUR GARDEN WHEN BUSTLING UP A DELICIOUS MEAL

ere are some tips for growing herbs in Gauteng, in autumn and winter.

The first step is to pick herbs that are hardy enough to weather cold Highveld winters. We recommend thyme, origanum, chervil. parsley and sage for culinary use. Thyme, sage and parsley also have strong medicinal properties and, to complement them, you can grow hyssop (for bronchitis) and varrow (for infections and fevers).

Herbs like sweet basil, borage, lemon balm and the various mints are too tender and will die down so it's worth treating them as summer annuals.

Herbs need at least four hours of sun in winter and a sheltered position. For this reason, they should be grown in pots so they can be moved around to follow the sun.

Choose containers that are a minimum of 20cm in diameter, have drainage holes and are deep enough for the herb's roots to develop. Use a normal commercial potting soil that drains well.

Herbs don't like wet feet so don't put saucers underneath the pots. Check the soil moisture levels daily because the soil should not dry out completely. Generally potted herbs only need to be watered once or twice a week in winter, preferably in the morning. Feed once a month with a liquid fertiliser, like Multisol, Nitrosol or Multifeed, at half the required strength.

When harvesting, collect small quantities at a time and always leave two growth points on the twig for re-shooting. Instead of cutting at random, rather use the opportunity to pinch out or prune the plant to encourage bushiness. Once picked, handle the herbs as little as possible because the subtle nuances of flavour are lost if handled or allowed to wilt.

Try Contour compost!!!

This is the best compost on the market. It is organic, it is a natural alternative to chemical fertiliser and much kinder to the environment. べ



BRICKATHON FUNDRAISING EVENT

t 09h30 on Saturday the 17th of March 2018, despite the pouring rain, almost 300 children from grade 1 to grade 12 at Cedarwood School formed a human chain from the old Corobrik depot next to Ludwig's Roses along Main Road to the end at Cedarwood School at 113 Dunmaglass Road, 2km away. Assisted by teachers, friends and family, they passed along a portion of the 11 000 bricks donated by Corobrick, towards the building of 10 new classrooms at the school. Some 20 odd students from Beaulieu Prep and College stepped in to assist their neighbouring school in this endeavour.

The 'Brickathon' was followed by a family fun day, with MixFm 93.8 conducting an outdoor broadcast in the rural setting of the school premises. There were various food vendors and activities including jumping castles, wheelbarrow races and Laser Tag on offer. Despite the weather, attendance was great and the children approached the event with smiles, good spirits and living up to the school motto: "Be the Best that You Can Be".

Building self-esteem in the children, pride for their school and parent involvement, were not the only objectives that were successfully met on the day. Cedarwood School also hoped to create public awareness of their unique school and what it offers, through the visibility of the event, the interviews on MixFM and the various articles published before and afterwards. SCHOOL EXPANSION PROGRAMME

Cedarwood School is a non-profit independent school that provides education to almost 300 children with mild to moderate learning support needs. Most of the children have come from schools that were unable to accommodate their specific needs, and the parents chose to place them at Cedarwood School. The School has also identified a situation within the broader community, and would like to extend their education offering to underprivileged children in the area in need of special education. In this way, Cedarwood School fills a gap in the education system, for without this help, these children run the risk of being 'lost' in mainstream schools.

For many of these children, there is no other school in the area to go to, especially none that has such a nurturing atmosphere, but yet has a strong focus on preparing and equipping the children with skills to become independent and productive adults. Cedarwood endeavours to build the whole child, with the assistance of dedicated remedially-trained teachers and specialists who help children with speech therapy, occupational therapy, remedial therapy, physiotherapy and psychotherapy. The replacement of the temporary classrooms will include modern facilities that cater to the special needs of the students, including full disabled access, therapy rooms and practical training centres (computers, cooking, etc).


Cedarwood School is a Non Profit Company (not for financial gain or profit, with no government subsidy or external funding) and is funded exclusively by the parents. The Brickathon was the beginning of fundraising for the school's phased College Building Project. To this end, it has acquired a neighbouring property and engaged architects to design a new college building. However, the cost of building these facilities is beyond the reach of the school in its current financial position. Further, the cost of financing such a project is likely to be unaffordable for the majority of the parents at the school.

The school board has, to date, been focussed on addressing the council and environmental approvals process and on liaising with the staff to ensure that the facilities are going to maximise the teachers' ability to assist children in the new College. They are now starting to engage more directly in trying to secure funding for this project. It is something they are all excited about and committed to achieving.



FORD MUSTANG 5.0L GT CONVERTIBLE

You either love American muscle cars or you don't, it's actually that simple.



Not youngsters (if they love cars) grow up with posters of 3 cars.....Lamborghini, Ferrari and the Ford Mustang. Ever since the Ford Mustang, known as the Pony, was first launched in 1964, the legend has grown, even here in South Africa where extremely limited numbers were imported over the years due to the cars being built as left-hand drive only. That all changed with the launch of the current generation, and every petrolhead and muscle car enthusiast in SA had reason to rejoice when it was announced that the first EVER right hand drive Mustang was being added to the range.

For a Sunday rally run recently, I arranged a special test drive of the top of the range V8 convertible version to use as my transport. To say it was the centre of attraction among a number of other special classic cars is an understatement. Many purists will tell you that the Mustang's handling and finishes still don't match some of the top European brands. My response is very simply I DON'T CARE. It's a Mustang. It's the quintessential American muscle car. It's big, it's loud and it can be 'In Yer Face', but that's exactly how it's meant to be.

The Mustang is available in SA with either a 2.3L Ford Ecoboost engine or the big, growling 5.0V8. Many believe that the 2.3, with 233kW is a far better buy from the aspect of the lighter engine giving better balance plus the lightning response from the turbo. The V8 has no turbo, so it kicks out 306kW and a massive 530Nm in a marginally lazy way. An easy test of the massive torque is that you can allow the car to rumble over the prolific speed bumps found in most estates without even touching the accelerator pedal. Then, when you click a little toggle switch below the infotainment screen and change from normal mode, to sport/race track or snow modes that's when the fun begins.

The Mustang is available in SA with either a 2.3L Ford Ecoboost engine or the big, growling 5.0L V8. Many believe that the 2.3L, with 233kW is a far better buy from the aspect of the lighter engine giving better balance plus the lightning response from the turbo. The V8 has no turbo, so it kicks out 306kW and a massive 530Nm in a marginally lazy way - until you click a little toggle switch below the infotainment screen and change from normal mode, to sport/race track or snow modes that's when the fun begins.

The Mustang is available in Coupe or Convertible versions with either engine and even manual or automatic transmissions with both engine choices. Here is where I am going to emphatically state my personal preference - V8 convertible with automatic transmission. How can you possibly contemplate your American Muscle car with any other recipe? Again being personal, I refused to drive with the top up. This is a selfish car, you cannot deny that. Back seat space is limited and the elements are harsh on those relegated to the cheap seats. But this is a car you buy for yourself (and maybe your loved one) and I only know one way to drive it - cruising down the highway with the top down listening to the classic V8 rumble.

Mustang prices range from R 720 000 to R 950 000 for the range topper as tested. All I can say is I want one just like this.

TEST REVIEW: VOLVO S90 T6 AWD R-DESIGN

As the large, luxury sedan in the Volvo line-up, the S90 is based on the same platform as their large SUV, the XC90. This immediately translates into a large and spacious sedan offering, placed squarely in the luxury segment.

Volvo surprised the market a few years ago by making the decision to limit engines throughout their range to a maximum of 2L and 4 cylinders. To appease the sceptics, they then added turbo and even superchargers for power output.

Our test car was the top of the range T6 version providing 235kW and 400Nm of torque from the engine. That's more than adequate in anybody's language, even more so when you engage Dynamic mode at the push of a button. This adds to the urge, holds the gearing and shifts while providing a growl to the already rapid pull-off.

The R-design kit combines some aggression with larger mag wheels, body kit and a few other small changes to make the car rather distinctive. Having said that, it is a very discreet car which almost slips under the radar in traffic whilst you travel along cosseted in absolute luxury.

Like every Volvo, the list of safety items is almost endless plus there are numerous autonomous

driving functions included like active cruise control, active braking and even autonomous parking. Becoming familiar in modern Volvos is the tablet-style infotainment system that contains every conceivable feature and configuration available, not to mention the upgraded Bowers and Wilkens sound system that turns your car into a concert hall.

The All Wheel Drive system fitted as standard on the T6 model enhances road holding and safety providing you with the comfort of knowing that there are always vast reserves of safety built-into the vehicle.

Overall, it's no surprise to me that the S90 was the runner up in the 2018 SA Car of the Year awards, I believe that this accolade is richly deserved. In a market segment that includes the Mercedes E-class, BMW 5 series, Lexus GS and Audi A6, the Volvo S90 is a true contender. The T6 has a base price of approximately R 900 000 before extras which is also extremely competitive in the sector, especially once you have equalised the full specification level of each vehicle.

NEW HYUNDAI GRAND i10 LAUNCHED

The Hyundai Grand i10 has become a familiar sight on SA's roads since its launch as big brother to the entry model i10. Somewhat larger, newer and with higher specs saw its position solidified in the Hyundai family.

Recently I was invited to attend the launch of the new Hyundai Grand i10, and to say that I was surprised is an understatement. With small changes, spec upgrades and improvements across the range, this goes beyond the level of a mere facelift of the old version.

Hyundai SA have pulled off a master stroke here.....the old baby i10 is no more. Now, the entry level Grand i10 replaces it with a larger car, more features and improved safety. YET, it is a full R 5000 cheaper than its previous baby brother. Proof of the extra space is provided by showing that luggage space increases from 144/756L in the old i10 up to a vastly increased 184/928L in the Grand i10.

The base models are powered by a little 1L 3 cylinder motor producing 48kW and 94Nm it is right there with all the competitors in this segment. You can choose between the base Motion or the middle spec Fluid version with this engine, and there's even an automatic version. Then you add factors like dual front airbags and ABS brakes, a basic infotainment system with Bluetooth and front electric windows AND Hyundai's market-leading 7 year/200 000km warranty.

The base models are powered by a little 1L 3 cylinder motor producing 48kW and 94Nm - it

is right there with all the competitors in this segment – making it a perfect run-around inside the Estate and for quick trips to the shops and back.

The larger engine option is Hyundai's familiar 1.2L 4 cylinder putting out a very respectable 64kW and 120Nm. With this engine you can choose between mid-spec Fluid or the top of the range Glide spec levels, again with an automatic option for town driving ease. On the road at launch, we drove the bigger engine 1.2L top spec Glide version and I came away highly impressed by the smoothness, quiet engine and ride. It was so quiet that both my co-driver and I tried to start the engine when it was already running!

This version offers full luxury features with items like daytime running lights, comprehensive touch-screen infotainment system and many more items that were the preserve of large luxury cars only a few years ago. After some time behind the wheel, I certainly felt as if I had been driving a far bigger and more expensive vehicle. With an entry price of ONLY R 149 900 for the 1.0L Motion manual ranging through to R 202 900 for the 1.2L Glide manual and R 206 900 for the 1.2L Fluid Automatic, I think Hyundai is on to a winner.




